

Recreational Coed Soccer League Indoor 2007/08 Information



Registration

Register at Intersport (209 Main St.) or Sport Yukon (4061 4th Ave.) until Monday October 15, 4pm. Register by the deadline to ensure you get on a team.

Cost

\$160 per player for full season (Oct. to late March)

\$90 per player for half season (Oct.-Dec. or Jan.-Mar.)

Pre-season welcome nights and skills improvement

Three free soccer clinics for beginners and those wanting to improve skills. Simon Pulido will lead us through some basic drills followed by a scrimmage. **Wed. Oct. 3, 8:30-10pm, Wed. Oct. 10, 8:30-10pm, Sunday Oct. 14, 7:30-9pm. All at fieldhouse, CGC.** No registration necessary. Those thinking about signing up for Rec Coed welcome!

Start dates

Regular season starts on Sunday October 21.

Game times: Sundays at 7:15pm or 8:15pm, Wednesdays at 8:30pm or 9:30pm, Thursdays at 9:30pm. Every team plays twice per week (Sunday and Wed. or Thurs.). Games are 1 hour long and start and end promptly because the fields are only booked for the hour game. Come early and warm up in the hallway if a field is not available.

Location: All games are at Canada Games Centre (CGC). Most games are in the fieldhouse (turf), some are in the flexihall.

Game format: This year all games will be full-field, using the small nets (hockey-net width but only 24" high). Goal keepers can't use hands. Use of the small nets promotes lots of passing and touches on the ball and discourages hard shots. The object is fun, recreation and team play and we think that the small nets lend themselves perfectly to our league.

Email and website only: League communication is through email and the web. We will also try to make special announcements at games when we can. Players who do not have a regular email address should find themselves an email buddy who will call them to relay information when there is an announcement by email.

When do I find out what team I am on?

There will be a mass email by Saturday October 20 attaching the team lists. If you use Hotmail, this message is likely to automatically go into your junk email folder. Check that folder and tag the sender of the league mail as OK. We will not be phoning players to inform them of teams. We will have team lists available on the website by October 21 though.
