



2007 Coed Outdoor Soccer Newsletter and Information Sheet

This info sheet provides league info for the 2007 outdoor season, and explains some changes to the league. We hope this helps players to understand what is going on for the 2007 outdoor season.

League Start Dates

Drop in will start on **May 14, at Vanier at 9:00 pm**. If we have a big turnout, $\frac{1}{2}$ the players will go down the hill to Christ the King (CKES).

Drop in will run from May 14 till May 24. **The league play begins on May 28, 2007.**

May 14 to May 24: Drop-in @ Vanier and Christ the King if the numbers are there. **9:00 p.m.**

May 28 - June 28: League games at: **Vanier, CKES and F.H. Collins: 9:00**, Mon & Thurs

July 2-August 16: League games at Vanier, CKES and F.H. Collins - **7:00**, Mon. & Thurs.

August 20 - freeze-up: Drop-in @ Vanier - **7:00** Mon. & Thurs. (earlier as it gets darker)

T-shirts will be distributed to team reps on **May 24, 2007**, prior to drop-in that night. It is every player's responsibility to show up during the first week to get their T-shirts. We cannot hold T-shirts for players who do not intend to play for the first while, so we ask that you arrange to get your shirt at the beginning of the season, **from your team rep**.

Team Reps

This season, each team will have a team rep. You will receive the name and contact info for your team rep when you receive your team info and schedule. Team reps will be the liaison between the teams and the executive. We hope that all players will consider being team reps, as we can't run the league without the help and efforts of our players.

Register Now!!!

This year, there will be **NO registration after May 19**. For anyone. So please do not ask. We will also be making an effort to keep league numbers at 120, so that teams are a manageable size. We ask that all players register as early as possible, and if you do not register, please do not come out and drop in once league play has started. We aren't insured for this, and it is very, very difficult to track or keep teams even when people do this.

No, you can't play with every single one of your friends.

We will not consider requests by groups of three or four to play on the same team. This is because it creates uneven teams, skills and age-wise. It also means that if all of the friends are off doing something else, the team has no players.

Student Rates

We realize students are often strapped for cash. Thus, we offer a student rate. The student rate of \$40.00 will be available until May 19, when the registration cut-off is. We will not reduce this amount any further, even if a student can't play the whole season.

League Philosophy

We say it all the time, but please respect that the league is about fun and helping everyone enjoy the game.

This league is **not** for players who want to score lots of goals, or who wish to play a competitive game. If we receive complaints about rough play with a particular player, we reserve the right to ask that player to leave the league. If you want to play competitive or fast-paced soccer, we encourage you to look into the other leagues in town: Mens, Womens and/or Over 35's.

Having said that, if you have concerns about a particular player, a friendly word may work best to rein in rough play. Or, let your team rep know that you have concerns, and the rep will let us know so we can deal with the matter as quickly as possible.
