If registered after April 3<sup>rd</sup>, player might be placed on a waiting list. We will not be able to accommodate all late registrants, but we hope to have room for all who register on time. **First come first serve applies.** (Some divisions might fill up during regular registration time.)

Requests to play up/down ONE division must be received in writing by April 7<sup>th</sup>, and may or may not be granted. Late requests will not be considered.

**Equipment:**

Shin guards covered by socks are mandatory. Players are required to wear shorts and the T-shirt WMS provides. In cold weather cross-field players may wear wind pants or tear-away pants. Soccer shoes (with cleats) are not mandatory, although they do provide better traction than runners.

**Referees.**

All players, coaches and parents are to respect the referee's authority. Absolutely no shouting at the referee! We keep losing young referees, because they are being yelled at repeatedly. Serious complaints regarding referees should be directed to the soccer office at 667-2445.
